After several years, it appears that the absence of opposition to this petition signals an end to the litigation.

There is one issue, however, and that is payment of fees. According to the petition, the estate has zero liquidity, which means that counsel is unable to extract either his statutory fee or his litigation costs at this time. Any proposed order will required a warning to the client consistent with Probate Code §§ 11424, 11750(b).
